41 Students and 2 Divisions at Barrowtown for 2021/2022

Effective September 16 Barrowtown went from 3 divisions down to 2, meaning there are now 2 classes in the school. K/1/2 with Alexis Cavacece and 3/4/5 with Terry Jung and Lorence Peters jointly, although Mr. Peters is on leave at the moment. It was announced to parents on September 10 that the school district made the decision to decrease the divisions at Barrowtown due to a lower enrolment than was expected. A teacher would have to leave, and Mrs. Crozier (the K/1 teacher for the past 14 years) volunteered to leave. We very much value all that Mrs. Crozier added to our school, and she is greatly missed. We had a Good Bye Assembly for her on September 15, which was her last day at Barrowtown.

Mr. Peter's substitute until he returns is Mrs. Cooper.

Mrs. Havery is also not back at Barrowtown this year, as her contract was up at the end of last year for Barrowtown. This year we have no EA positions, and with the loss of Mrs. Crozier, our teachers will not have a lot of extra support.

No PE teacher has been added for this year as well. Teachers will have to teach PE as well.

This year we are allowed to do more events and field trips again. This can include providing Pancake Day and Popcorn Day, each once a month, now that parent volunteers are allowed back in the school this year.
