- 1. Terry is absent, no Principal's Report
- 2. President Report: Kayla
 - a. Magnet Wall:
 - i. Kayla contacted her plumbing supplier they can look into sourcing clear tubing but it doesn't sound likely.
 - ii. Jolene found a company form the states that have Magnet Wall supplies. They have a variety of options that seem very reasonably priced. We can order some of the basic pieces to start. There are packages that total less than the gaming grant funds so it should be within our budget. Terry mentioned previously that the school could use their grant for some of the magnet wall as well so if the cost is more after converting to Canadian dollars the school should be able to cover the extra.
 - iii. Kayla motioned to purchase the magnet wall supplies with the gaming grant fund of \$2,067.79 from wintergreen.com.— Jolene seconded, all in favour—moved. Jolene will continue to be in contact with this company.
 - b. Grade 5 Camp:
 - i. Kayla suggested that we keep it simple, an outside camp day, as we had discussed previously. This is the schools' responsibility to plan though so the PAC will make a suggestion that the Grade 5 celebration is a camp day at a local park (such as Vedder Campground or Brown Creek Wetlands) with a scavenger hunt, camp style games, and a campfire (with hot dog and marshmallow roast if permitted). The PAC can provide financial support for the celebration once plans have been made. We can also help pick up food if we aren't able to roast hot dogs.
 - ii. Alisa will share our proposal with the staff at their next staff meeting.
 - c. After discussing Emilia's proposal from last meeting PAC has decided to purchase these. Kayla motioned to buy two sets of the 7 layer Towers of Hanoi for \$27.50 each (\$55.00) and one of the 10 layer game for \$12.50 from Wal Mart, the total cost will be \$74.70 including tax and free shipping. Alisa seconded, all in favour, moved.

- d. Kayla has receipts to reimburse Melissa for Dairy Queen (once we cnfirm this wasn't already paid) and Alisa for Easter Chocolate \$31.27
- e. Georgia suggested purchasing 3-in-1 outdoor games from Wal-Mart to use for events. They include bean bag toss, washers, and ladder ball. Georgia motioned to buy three of the 3-in-1 outdoor game sets from Wal-Mart for \$39.98 each, Kayla seconded, all in favour, moved.
