

Dear Barrowtown Parents,

Keeping our Barrowtown children and staff safe is a high priority during this very challenging time. One of the most difficult safety measures to follow is not being able to invite parents and family members to school (unless a prior arrangement is worked out ahead of time). However, we must keep following the direction from our provincial health authority and/or school district. As difficult as it is, we must send out a reminder for parents and family members to keep within the boundaries of the parking lot areas prior to the start of school, during school, and until the school busses leave after school. When dropping off and picking up children at the boundaries of the parking lot, parents and family members are asked to wear a mask if outside their vehicle and to social distance from other children who are waiting for the bus or to be picked up.
