1. Principal's Report: Terry/President's Report:Kayla
 - a. Talent show went well, there was a good variety of talents, because Terry's phone was used for music there were not many pictures taken.
 - b. Class pictures will be tomorrow, Terry suggested having a PAC photo. Kayla will contact some PAC volunteers to see if there is interest.
 - c. The school is working on 215 feathers to fit together into a large feather to commemorate the 215 bodies found on the residential school grounds. The school continues to discuss "every child matters."
 - d. June 21st is Aboriginal Day, the school will be discussing Aboriginal cultural appreciation.
 - e. It doesn't look like parents will be allowed to come to the school to join the grade 5 graduation celebration. It will likely be recorded and shared electronically.
 - f. Sports Day will be June 16th or 23rd (weather dependent). The district will allow a minimum number of parent volunteers, they need to be current PAC volunteers. Terry asked Melissa and Kayla, both are able to come. He will also ask the noon hour supervisors.
 - i. The PAC would like to contribute towards Hot Lunch for Sports Day. We still have \$269.91 from gaming that we could use towards lunch. Jim's pizza was chosen, we can also provide chips, juice, ice cream sandwiches and granola bars. Based on the cost of pizza we should be able to cover the whole cost, Kayla motioned to purchase all of the Hot Lunch: pizza, juice boxes, ice cream sandwiches, chips and granola bars. Melissa seconded, all in favour-moved.
 - g. The gaming grant needs to be applied for by June 30th, we need to gather the papers we need and submit our application.

- h. PAC Council for next year: Kayla's 4 year term is ending at the end of the school year, Melissa is willing to stay on, she would prefer to continue as secretary. Angie is willing to continue as treasurer if no one else is able to take over, it would also be preferable if meetings could be held after school so she can attend. Melissa suggested holding meetings at 3:30 so we can have more council members in attendance. For now we will leave our PAC Council as: Melissa as secretary, Angie as Treasurer and the rest of the positions vacant. Hopefully some new parents are able to join in September. Meetings will be at 3:30, day to be decided.
