1. President Report: Kayla/Principal's Report: Terry
 - a. Magnet Wall:

 - ii. Jolene suggested doing a camp day at the school. Terry agreed, they will also try to spread out different activities throughout the coming weeks (bike rides, geocaching, etc.) aiming to have one special activity a week to celebrate the grade 5s.
 - iii. Terry suggested the possibility of going to Wild Play in Maple Ridge. It may be more expensive but PAC is willing to pay for at least a portion for the grade 5s.
 - f. The school has had to look at ways to reduce the possibility of exposure from the older siblings that attend middle/high schools as there are many more cases there and we want to reduce the risk of exposure for our school community. Because of this, the school has asked families to stay off of school grounds before/after school.
 - g. Sports Day
 - i. Terry said the school will be able to do a Sports Day because they are all one cohort. Parents will likely not be able to attend.

- ii. Jolene suggested the PAC can sponsor lunch and maybe individually wrapped ice creams. Pizzas were suggested for lunch, everyone agreed on sponsoring the lunch and ice creams.
